
BASALITE® PROJECT EXPERIENCE - PERMEABLE PAVERS

As part of a multi-million dollar modernization project for Berkeley High School, the pedestrian walkways around Yellowjacket Stadium are now made of Basalite SF Rima permeable pavers. Chosen by San Francisco Architect Baker Vilar for both aesthetics and functionality, approximately 10,000 square feet of permeable pavers were installed.

The Berkeley Athletic Complex will celebrate its grand opening when school begins in the fall of 2012.
